# Context


By end-2014:

- 59.5 mln individuals were forcibly displaced worldwide as a result of persecution, conflict, generalized violence, or human rights violations
- UK had 153,560 people of concern to UNHCR in 2014, including
- 40,329 asylum applicants, of them 11,795 were granted refugee status (10,734) or humanitarian protection (1,061)
- UK 17<sup>th</sup> in the list of European countries by percentage of refugees in the total population (1.85)
- Coventry one of the UK's 12 dispersal cities






### Integration: How we see it


"Integration means creating the conditions for everyone to play a full part in national and local life" (DCLG, 2012)






