- Evidence on Strong Communities is key to enabling effective, rapid and innovative local responses to local priorities-achieving outcomes and realising savings.



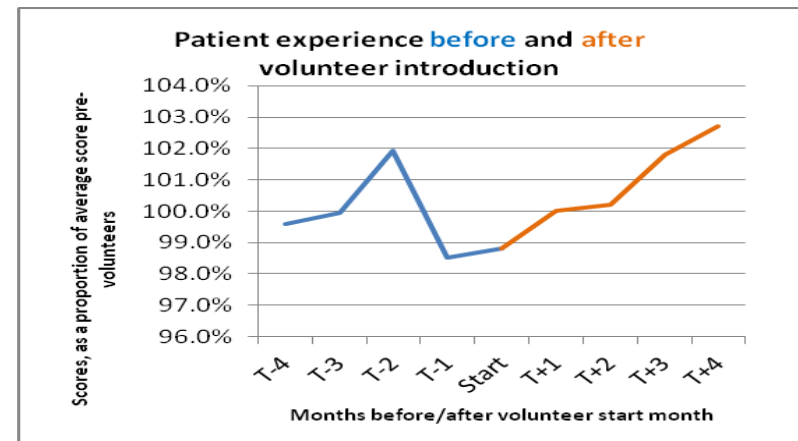
