

CO-PRODUCTION STAR ACTION LEARNING TRAINING PROGRAMME:

A five step approach for effective co-production

Learning objectives:

1. Delegates learn to map, focus, people, market and grow new co-production approaches based on a step-by-step action learning programme, which involves five half-day workshops and two facilitated half-day Co-Production Labs.
2. The action-learning programme includes experimentation with the co-production projects which have been designed in these Co-Production Labs, typically over a period of 100 days.
3. The Co-Production Star Action Learning Programme is tailored to bring together a wide range of stakeholders, including commissioners, top and middle-managers, front-line staff, third sector providers, service users and local communities.
